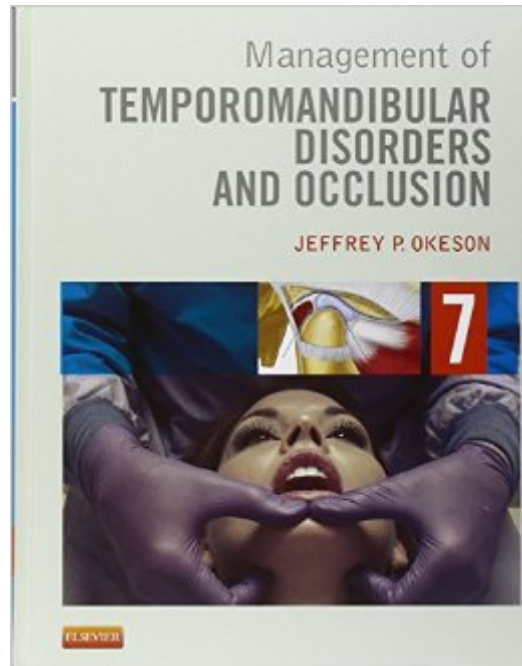

They clearly give you the impression that they are a USA based company, but when the book is shipped to you it arrives from New Delhi, India (that should tell you something right there). No bends, creases or marks on the package itself.
